Need for Credible Information

- Decide what kind of information families and healthcare providers need to make informed decisions about taking care of a person who has a rare disorder.
- Develop ways to decide if information on a rare disorder is accurate.
- Create new ways to help people develop accurate information about rare disorders.

ATCGRN

- A CDC funded grant
- \$4 million budget
- Purpose: to examine evidence based information
- Result: Toolbox for consumers to access information

Quality information about genetic conditions should be readily available to individuals and families affected by genetic conditions. Condition-specific advocacy organizations are the premier providers of this information. These organizations provide the tools needed to cope day to day, find solutions, obtain services, and heal. They know first-hand what it means to be faced with a diagnosis and the subsequent need for accurate information. As experts in their condition, advocacy groups are highly motivated to keep this information up-to-date and accessible and to share it with the community.

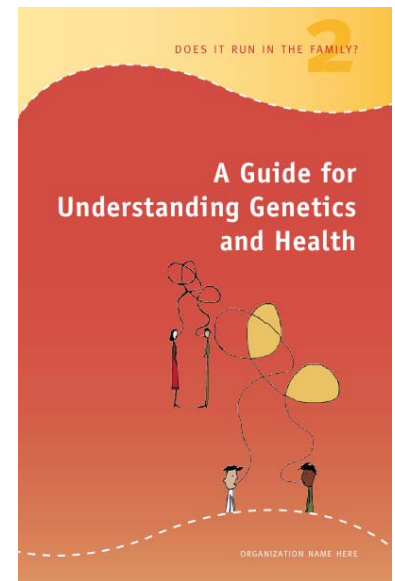
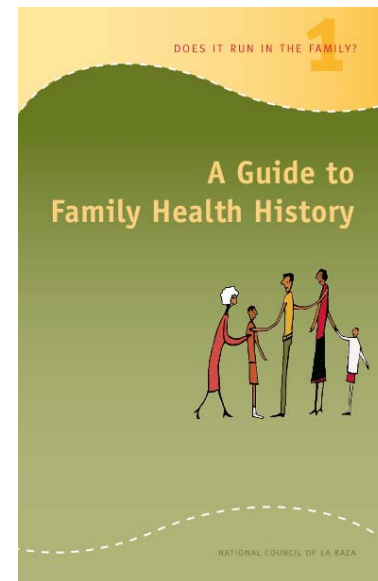
