

## **Bruno Sepodes**

Bruno Sepodes holds a PhD in Pharmacy (Pharmacology) by the University of Lisbon. Currently a Professor of Pharmacology and Pharmacotherapy at the Faculty of Pharmacy of the University of Lisbon, Bruno is also the Chair of the Committee for Orphan Medicinal Products (COMP) and member of the Committee of Human Medicinal Products (CHMP) at the European Medicines Agency in London, extending his membership also to the Committee of Advanced Therapies (CAT). His collaboration with the European Medicines Agency started as a member of the COMP in 2008 and followed as a member of the Patients' and Consumers Working Party during 2012. Bruno Sepodes is an expert for the National Medicines Authority (INFARMED) and for the Veterinary General Directorate (DGV). He is author and co-author of several scientific publications in international journals, and a multitude of scientific communications (on pharmacology, immunopharmacology, pharmacotoxicology, therapeutics and regulatory science), presented to national and international scientific meetings.
